GUIDELINES FOR POSTER/ORAL PRESENTATION

Instructions for Poster Presentation (Offline)

- Topic should be relevant to the theme of the conference.
- Posters should be prepared in PORTRAIT format and in English only. Poster stand: Vertical type.
- Poster size: 24 x 36 inch. Contents of the poster and letters must be readable from a distance of 3 feet.
- Poster content should be divided into the following sections: Title, Authors, Affiliation, Introduction, Material and Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusion and References.
- The name(s) of the author(s), address (es) should be written below the title in small letters along with email id.
- Figures and diagrams must be simple and self-explanatory.
- Corresponding authors will be notified about the day, time, and venue for the display. The presenting author must be present during the display of the poster.
- One author can present only one poster. The presenting author name should be underlined and should be registered for the Conference.
- Abstracts not complying with any of the above conditions will not be accepted.
- The time given to present poster will be 3 minutes and 2 minutes for a question session.

Instructions for Presentation of E-Posters (Online)

Please submit your E-Poster as a 1-page PDF-file in portrait orientation.

Please read the following technical requirements:

- File format: PDF (one page only). Contents of the poster and letters must be readable.
- English should be used to prepare all e-Posters. Add an abstract number to the title (and when you upload your e-Poster).
- The resolution of each image in your poster should be 150-300 dpi.
- Font size: 16-24

Instructions for Oral Presentation (Offline/Online)

- The topic should be relevant to the selected discipline/thrust area.
- Topic presented by the presenting author should be his/her own research work.
- The time given to present oral presentation will be 8 minutes and 2 minutes for a question session.
